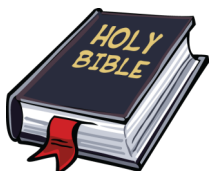

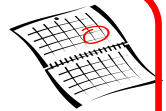

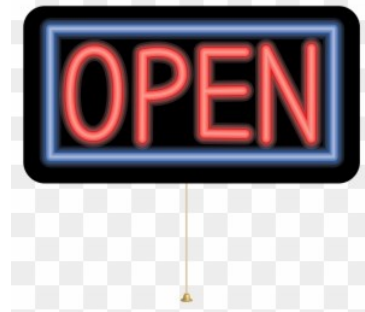

### Boys Summer Uniform

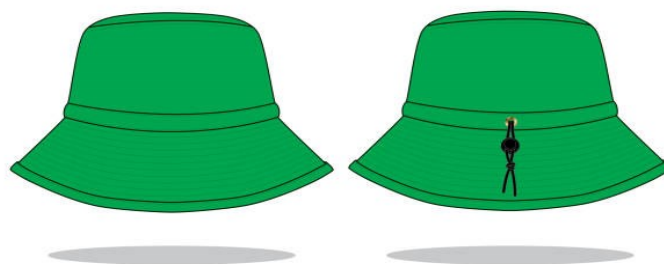
Grey polo shirt with school monogram, grey summer shorts. Black or brown sandals.
