



# NEW 2-TERM SPORTS SEASONS

This summer season we will be falling in line with some other schools by implementing a new 2-Term approach to sports. The Summer season will comprise of Term 4 and the following year's Term 1. Term 4 teams will automatically roll over into Term 1 (except Yr 8s).

Because this is the first time we are doing this, before school starts next year you will be asked to re-confirm your child's place in the team. We will also put out a call inviting new players to join.

The winter season will be Terms 2 and 3. Fees will still be on a Term by Term basis unless otherwise stated.

The rationale for this change is that we start Term 1 later than many other schools, and Sports Clubs need teams registered before we return to school. By using a 2-Term season, there's no need to worry about registering your child over the Christmas/New Year break, because it's already done!
