Building Work @ SPC

The alterations to Rooms 6 and 7 are on track to be completed ahead of schedule. The students will move back into the classes within the first weeks of Term 4.

During the term break work will be completed on the rerouting of underground cabling and services in preparation for the start of work on the new multi-purpose building.

Tender documents inviting contractors to price the construction of the multi-purpose room have been sent out. Our hope is work will commence in term 4.

Hastings Visitors

On Wednesday 25th September we hosted 14 teachers from 6 schools in Hastings. The purpose of the visit was to learn about our school's adoption of the Relationship-based Teaching and Learning Approach. We also discussed our inclusion of Writers Toolbox and the Structured Literacy Programmes.

We had students sharing their work and the teachers visited some class-rooms. Comments made by the visitors included: 'That was inspiring', 'I know where we are heading now', 'The students are really engaged and understand their learning', and 'This is such a lovely calm environment'.



NEW 2-TERM SPORTS SEASONS

This summer season we will be falling in line with some other schools by implementing a new 2-Term approach to sports. The Summer season will comprise of Term 4 and the following year's Term 1. Term 4 teams will automatically roll over into Term 1 (except Yr 8s).

Because this is the first time we are doing this, before school starts next year you will be asked to re-confirm your child's place in the team. We will also put out a call inviting new players to join.
